I came across Francis Carter when passing through her yard. Mrs. Carter Francis stopped me and started to complain of her sickness. She showed her swellen hands and legs. She cannot work any more. All this is from hank the heart. She has some heart trouble, has been examined by the dectors, but so far no remedy has been found for her. She initimated of having no money, and being unable to earn any. I offered her a cigarette, which she accepted readily.

She was alone in the house with 4 children pixing playing inside the house. I asked whose are the children. Exertiments Electronic Her dughter's. Her daughter name is Elea Dixon. She is not at home; went to the river.

They live in a thatch house with a floor, and divided into 2 rooms. A grass kitchen is near-by.

I was told later on in the village that Carter Francis is the daughter of John Carter. All the family kningxkaxkkaxk are of the Anglican denomination with if the Census records, with the exception of Dixon Israel, who is described as having knew "no religion".

Carter Francis and other grown-up mamak members of the family, are described in the Census as farm labourers. Carter Francis does not figure either in Farm schedule nr2, or in F.Sch.nr.3. This indicates that the family has no property of bux their own.

The realtionship of Carter Francis and her household to John Carter or to Dixon's family has to be

studied.
