Miss Eda gave us additional information conerning

Ernest Dale's family.

He lives in Allsides on a hill near Allsid s house.

Does not stay - to Miss Eda's knowledge - with his mother in law, Ann Smith. Bought recently a piece of land from below Mendez's Victor shop and intex plans to build his new house here. He paid L.17 for this house-site. Brought probably more than 1.100 from America.
