

When Clifton Powell was a very small boy his father left the numerous family, left the island and never came back. He never wrote to his wife. Clifton knows he went to Cuba as he wrote a few times to the grandfather asking for money for the passage to come back. The old man sent him the money a few times, but he never came back. Clifton was adopted by his aunt Margaret Roach who did not have any children of her own, When Joseph Roach (husband of Margaret) died he made a will and gave the land to Clifton as he was a "dutiful child" (which is not correct as in the census Clifton only rents the land from Margaret). His brothers and white sisters were not so lucky and dont have sucha lot of land. He has round the house 3 acres: he always manures his land very well with natural manure. He cultivates a bit of everything, even of tobacco, his year he doesntoultivate tobacco for market although the price is good he was late with it.

In the yard there are three buildings and a shed there is the living house, the kitchen and a buttery. Clifton is happy and proud of his farm and position. He never traveled abroad - he stayed all the time in Bull Savannah. Sometimes on Sundays he goes to fish in the remarker in the remark with the rod, and to swimm. There is a good place where the river goes into the sea. He used to go fishing, but there is kaxmaxx too much stealing, you set your pods and people steal them. He does not go fishing any more - has enough work on his farm. His land in three places is adjoining to Isaac Johnson's land.

When I was in this house some months ago Margaret was ill and lying on a wooden couch in the kitchen. Today she was in the kitchen eating her dinner (about 5 p.m.) Margaret was standing near the fire and was helping herself from the pot. Her niece Valerie and a older woman (introduced as "servant") were sitting on the couch and eating a peas soup. Just outside the kitchen the niece Tur nika was washing the feet of the small girl Delva.

If the land belongs to Clifton Powell as he says, he should be considered the head of the household as on him rest all the productive activities in this "family".

Margaret Roach is an extremely bad informant. She is hard of hearing and to be on Ithe safe side answers every question with "Yes Ma'am" even if asked for a name. I got the names and the persons living here from Valerie who was rather in an ungracious humour as she just quarrelled with her aunt over a bammy she got and didn't like.

I brought for Margaret greetings from her intelligent energetic sister Caroline Powell from Bottom (F.R. 241

to which Margaret replied "Yes Ma'am".

Margaret Roach is the daughter of Nathaniel and Jane Francis. She has two brothers Stanley and Charles Francis who live in B. Sav. Out of her 7 sisters 2 are only alive and live in B. Sav. Margaret married over 30 years also Joseph Roach son of Elhena and Martha Roach. (For his brothers see p.l. of this F.R.) Margaret didn't have children and adopted a few of her late sisters who weren't so lucky in life. (For the story of her sisters see F.R. 87 p.4 and check with 241 p. 6)

StiftmaxRams After the death of Margaret's husband the nephew Elifton Fowell took charge of the cultivations.

Frank wright is the grand-son of Dorothy Francis. The Frank's mother was Annella Work daughter of Dorothy. His father was Fitz Wright.

Delva Powell is the daughter of Clifton Powell and Ida Dyer - Calbert Dyer's daughter. (MANDERS WILLIAM)

The land. According to Margaret they have 50 acres of land; 6 of home land, 20 in Thatch Walk and the rest in the woodlands. How this land was acquired and to whom it belongs legally I sumlant wasn't able to get.
