Mrs Dyer was out in the garden when I called. She led us both inside the house into a little sitting room. Her house stands on the far side of the main road, at Ridge. It is well constructed, with roofing, not thatching. It is has a verandah, and goes back a long way, with additional buildings at the back, made in the ordinairy thatched style. There is a well kept tank in the front of the house, a nice flowere garden that is now covered in flowers, and at the back an apiary could be seen. The whole impression was one of prosperity, and comfort. Edna herself is pleasant and self confident, with very little apologies for her appearance, or for the inside of the house, which was actually very neat and clean.

She was ready to talk when I had explained the object of the survey, in which she seemed very interested.

### Parentage.

Father was called Hubert Witter, Her mother was called Lydia Witter.

There were eleven children, 7 brothers and 4 sisters. These were all the children of both parents, as there were no outside children.

Marriage. She has been married 12th years to Algernon Dyer and they have lived in this house most of this time. She got married from her parent's home.

#### Her children.

For all her confinements she has had Miss Francella Simpson to look after her, and she has found her very good. She comes in the early stages of labour but goes away again as occasion arises. Sometimes there are two confinements at the same time, and she is forced to go from one to another. She help

considerably with the pains, and gives the mother strengthening foods, and after the baby is born the mother is given some drink such as rum.

She has never had much trouble at the actual birth, no nor has she ever felt in the least sick during the period of pregnancy, apart from the ordinairy early "morning sickness". However after the baby has been born she usually gets something wrong with her. With the first baby she got very bad abcesses on her breasts and she had great difficulty in feeding the baby. She then gave it up for the mix first six months. It was the same after each of her other children, although she never had the same breast trouble again, sometimes it was her kidneys, orm something similair, but there has always been an illness of some kind.

She weaned her first child then at 1 year old. She uses the method of having some warm cows milk, or tinned milk, which she gives the baby at night, a d if he should wake up in the night, she keeps some handy to give him straight away.

She weamed them all at different ages. The second one was weamed at 13 months. The third one was weamed at 8 months.

the next at 5 months, (she explained that this was because her breasts strted to burt again, so in order to avoid the same trouble recoccuring the doctor advised her to stop nursing the baby.)

The present baby, 8 months old has not yet been weaned.

The fact that she has had five boys in succession has made it very difficult for her to manage. Boys cannot help in the house, nor can they help with the baby. In order to get some help, she has been forced to adopt a little girl, called Viola Powell, who has now been living with her for 6 years. Viola is fourteen.

Her parents are:- Joshua Powell.

Mehellla Powell.

Viola now very rarely goes to see her parents, although she still goes occasionally. Mrs Dyer regards her as one of her own.

Training. Children cannot be expected to use the chimmey properly until at least 14 months. They are not able to wash themselves and keep clean until they are around six yes years old.

Upbringing. She tries to bring them properly, but it is not too easy. The children around here are wild and "fasty". They curse and swear, and their parents do nothing about it, they are as bad themselves. Her boys pick this up when they go and play with them. Luckily as there are xxx a good number of them, (her sons) they are able to play amongst themselves a lot of the time. She tries to keep them in entirely in their own yard, and she doesn't allow the other children to come in and play with them. Whenever she hears them swearing she gives the a good

flogging, and she mkes sure it is a good one. Their father does not flog them, she has to do it all herself. She cannot always keep them away from the other local children, but she can only do her best in the matter.

The older children go to school every day, they never miss except when they are xx ill. They do not buy the school dinners because they come homexfromxkhmirx for their dinner. It is quite a long way, she knows, but a whole gang of them come together, and it becomes really a party with them, and they like to get away from school, and the school surroundings. They come by the main road.

The baby came into the middle of the inter view. She is already crawling and seemed very happy and well looked after. She had been in the charge of Viola.

I called in today for a few minutes to take a photograph of Mrs Dyer and the Baby. She was dressed in her dirty working clothes and looked generally more untidy than the day before. Nevertheless she did not hesitate, or make the slightest attemp to excuse herself and change, but quite happily stood outside the house, holding the baby, who was equally dirty, and wasted no time at all.
