#### Present House -hold

# Family History.

Roberta Clerk (nee Newis ) is the daughter of Leah Powell and Phillip Lewis . Her father did not marry her mother. Her father came to live in bull Savannah from Burn Ground in Santa Gruz . She does not know how or when her father came to live in Bull Savannah . Her mother is from Bull avannah .

Her parents are dead . She doesn not know any of her grand parents . She has one sister alive . Her sister is Agnes Foster, and is living Rocky Point . Roberta is 80.

# Her Sister Caroline .

Roberta did not grow with her sister mother, she grew with her sister Caroline Banton (nee Lewis). She and Caroline are sisters by father side, but not by mother. Roberta's father did not own her. "You no know wile people ". Her sister Caroline saw that she resembles the other daughters for the father, so Caroline took her and "raise her ".

Later on the father owned wher " She stayed with Caroline until Caroline died , and she buried her Caroline has left her house and five acres of land for ke Roberta. She did not R get any thing from her parents . The bigger ones took away everything . She got onlywhat her sister 1 left for her .

# Trading & Her Living .

She has been trading all her life, "from s me a young gal till now, and when me/speculate me work at the factory " She trades on sugar , coffee, bammies and "every little thing ". Sometimes she sells bread at her house . She buys from the baker and sell for her kirkwinek self.

She has been working at the factory from the work began . When the building was being x erected she worked for 72d per day . Later on she worked in the shed for 1/6 per day , and in the crop this year she got 2 - perday for working in the shed . "When the work start the pay no did good at all . You almost did dey gi, you labour fe nothing . A lately them raise the pay."

### Her Husband .

David he r husband is from Ballards Valley. She and David were living together before they were married. She had five children for David, four are dead and one is alive. She had four before marriage and one after she was married. They are margied now 28 years. Her husband's parents are were Robert lerk and Mary Clerk of Ballards Valley.

Her husband does a little cultivating, "no nothing much". He plants about & acre of tomato and & acre of peas cassava and yam together. He does not rent land to plant his things. He uses his wife's land to do so. He plots fish pods and sell to fishermen. She does not know how he sells them.

#### School .

Roberta did not go to school . "The old people them never in a hastefe send you . You hardly did have school those day, only one and two here and there . The old school building that them did have mash down and the old teacher dead . Then after that them build up the church that dey near the school . Them use to keep school and church in a the one building . Never bother with school that time".

# Bereta .

Bereta is the only child Roberta has living . She was born after her mother was married . She has four children for Phillip Thompson . Phillip lives at Top Bull Savannah The children are Harvey, Hazeett, Blossom, and Delu. Harvey is staying with his father, and the others are with Bereta.

"When Blassom born the father no did own her", so the grand mother oberta said that Blossom came from God into a basket and twine. That is why they gave her the name of Blossom. She is a flower. "Him own Blossom now. You know how x wha make him own her im did wan go a America pon the Contract. 'im no did dey min' the baby and the mother bring im up" (took him to court for maintainance) As he did not want his was name "to go in a Government book for when 'im name in the book they wouldn't take himpon the Contract". So he started to support the child. He loves the Blossom more than all the others.

Hazett goes to school, and Blossom and the baby are at home. Bereta, Hazett and the baby dox not sleep at Roberta's house. They sleep at another little house that Roberta was living in before she started to live in the

some of /

one she is now living in . During the day Bereta and her children are at her mother Roberta's yard . She does her cooking at her mother's yard and stays there all day but at nights she and/her children sleep in the little house .

Blossom sleeps at her grand mother's home along with her grand wax parents.

Bercta works at the factory all the time. She has worked in the Backing House, the cannery, and the shed. Sometimes she does labelling too. In the Packing House she gets lid per box, in the cannery she peels fruits at lid per dish. To do the labelling she gets 2d per case and 1/6 per day to work in the shed. "Is only this year me no work as me did have the young baby, but all them other year me work".

She does washing sometimes for Mrs Violet Lewis four days for the week, and sometimes for Mrs Geraldime Lewis She is paid by the day. She gets 1/6 per day, for washing and ironing. She does washing forother people too.

#### Agnes Banton & Ferdinand Elliott.

Agnes and Ferdinand are two children that Roberta adopted. They havegrown up andheve taken their own way. Ferdinand is still attached to her, but Agnes lives by herself, not fer from Roberta.

#### Agnes.

Agnes is the child of Lucie Rowe and Joseph Banton.
Joseph is the brother of Roberta's sister's husband. The child was staying with Caroline and after Caroline at attained Roberta who was staying at her sister Caroline's house took care of Agnes. Roberta has given Agnes a piece of the land that Caroline left for her. Agnes lives on the land now, She has "plenty children". Agnes' father Joseph is dead,

# Ferdinand .

Ferdinand grew with Roberta. He is the son of Moses Elliott and Francella Lewis. Francella is Roberta's sister. Francella is dead. Roberta took Ferdinand when he was nine months old from his mother. Francella was going away to coky Point to live so Roberta took the baby. "Him stay withme till him turn big man, and then him go look fe him mother". He stayed with his mother for nine months, and kmx came back.

When his mother died he went to bury her. After the funeral he came home. He used to work on the road when the road was being made, and he used to work at the factory weighing fruits. He made a little money and then he

started to build a"little house "on a spot that Robertal gave him. He is now in America. He went away on the Contract. He has been away five years now. He went away before the house was rompleted finished. He sends money and parcel for Roberta and his father all the time. Roberta has finished the house since he is away.

He is doing well in America. He was married on Christmas night to one Miss Odel Carter. He has sent the picture of his wife and himself to Roberta. Roberta has framed the picture nicely. In the picture Odel looks very fair and rather am stout. She is sitting, while the husband is standing. They are both in wedding apparel. Roberta is expecting Ferdinand out in October. She is very proud of the picture. "A fe me own son that a me raise him till him come big and abbe se help himself".

Roberta does not know if Ferdnand's wife will be an coming out when Ferdinand is coming. He is coming to have his papers fixed fixed so that he can go back on his ewn to America, and not on the Contract. Roberta stays in Ferdinand's house and is keeping it until he comes home. She is looking forward to his coming, and how glad she will be to see him.
